The International College of Integrative Medicine (ICIM) will be hosting a three-day conference for physicians and other health professionals to explore the integrative concepts that can help keep patients' immune systems vigilant and functioning optimally. Topics will include allergy, autoimmunity, inflammation, chronic sequestration, and effective biofilms.

Dr Jaffe will be sharing his thoughts on the beneficial aspects of "The Alkaline Way". The topic of his talk is: **Tolerance and Resilience: From collagen to platelets, occult blood and the Alkaline Way**

1. Know clinical importance of tolerance verses hypersensitivity in immune responses
2. Understand the basis by which the **Alkaline Way** reverses metabolic acidosis and induces disease remission
